

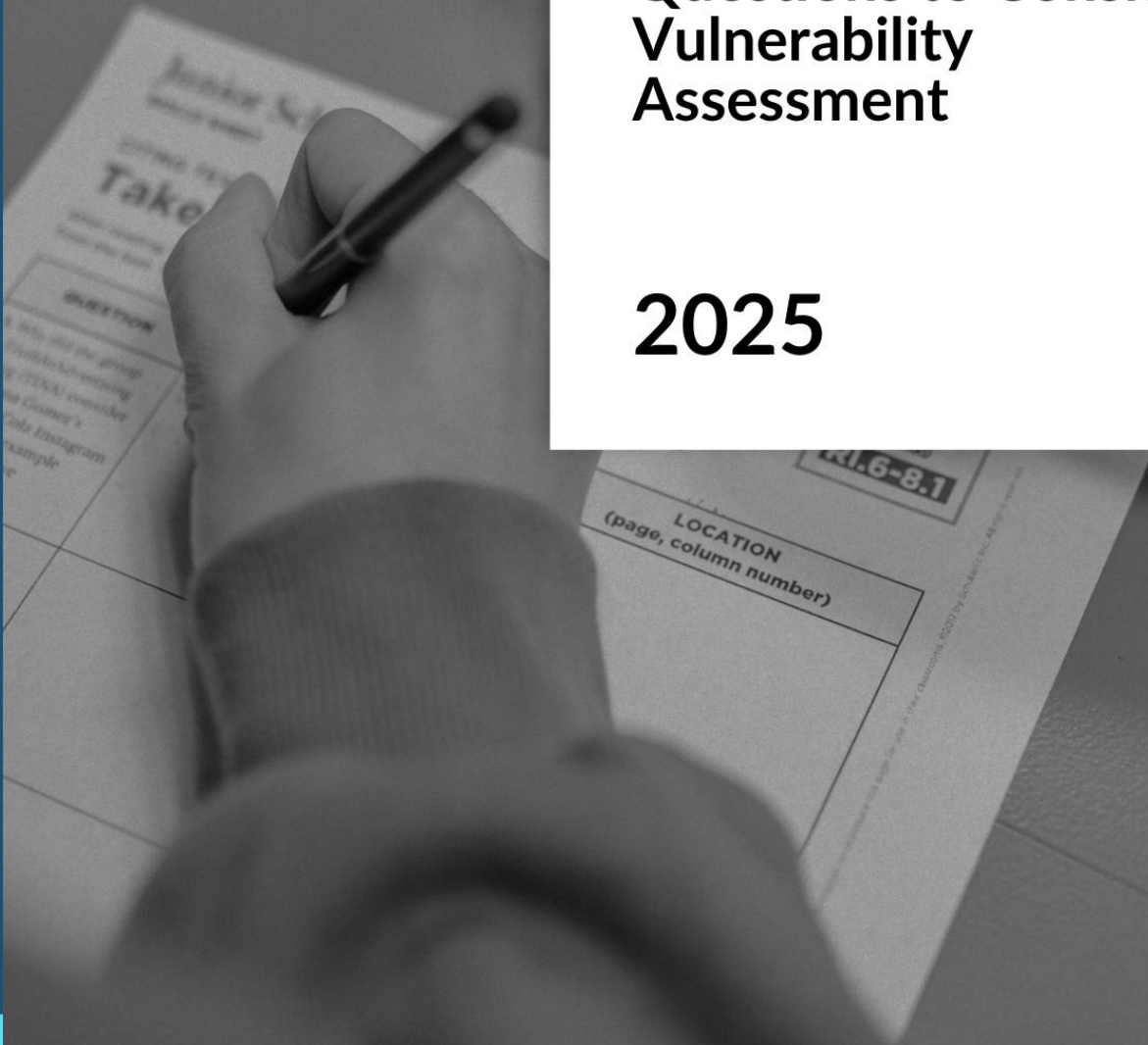

## Appendix O - Questions to Consider: Vulnerability Assessment

### Social Vulnerability

Focus Area/Theme	Questions
<b>Social Vulnerability</b>	<p>Demographics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What demographic characteristics are present in the community?</li> <li>• How does socioeconomic status influence vulnerability?</li> <li>• What are the employment rates, and what jobs do residents hold?</li> <li>• How does income disparity affect access to resources and services?</li> <li>• What is the level of home ownership versus renting, and how does this impact stability and recovery?</li> </ul> <p>Access:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What access to resources and services do community members have?</li> <li>• Are there adequate healthcare facilities, educational institutions, and social services available?</li> <li>• How do short- and long-term housing constraints impact vulnerability?</li> <li>• How accessible are transportation options, especially during emergencies?</li> <li>• Are there community support systems and networks in place?</li> <li>• Are resources and services safe and accessible? Who are they safe and accessible for?</li> </ul> <p>Language:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How do language and communication barriers affect vulnerability?</li> <li>• What languages are spoken in the community, and how proficient are residents in the dominant language?</li> <li>• How will emergency warnings and information be communicated to non-English speakers?</li> </ul> <p>Social/Health Disparities and Inequities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What social and health disparities exist within the community?</li> <li>• Are there prevalent health conditions that increase vulnerability, such as chronic illnesses or disabilities?</li> <li>• How do social determinants of health, like education and housing quality, affect community resilience?</li> <li>• How do existing social inequalities exacerbate disaster impacts?</li> <li>• How do factors like gender, race, and socioeconomic status intersect to create compounded vulnerabilities?</li> <li>• Are there groups that have historically faced discrimination or marginalization?</li> </ul> <p>Capacities and Strategies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What coping capacities and adaptive strategies do community members have?</li> <li>• How well-prepared are residents for potential hazards?</li> <li>• What local knowledge and skills exist that can enhance community resilience?</li> </ul>

<b>Integration and Action</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How will social and cultural vulnerability data be collected and analyzed?</li><li>• What methods will be used to gather quantitative and qualitative data?</li><li>• How will community members be engaged to provide input and share their experiences?</li><li>• How will the results of the vulnerability assessments be communicated and used?</li><li>• What strategies will be employed to share findings with stakeholders and the community?</li><li>• How will the assessments inform the development of targeted risk reduction strategies?</li><li>• How can emergency management practices be adapted to address identified vulnerabilities?</li><li>• What specific interventions will be implemented to reduce social and cultural vulnerabilities?</li><li>• How will ongoing monitoring and evaluation ensure the effectiveness of these interventions?</li></ul>

<p><b>Cultural Vulnerability</b></p>	<p>Beliefs and Practices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What cultural beliefs and practices influence or protect against vulnerability?</li> <li>• How do cultural norms and traditions affect the community's perception and response to hazards?</li> <li>• What assumptions are being made about culture?</li> <li>• Are there specific cultural practices that could increase risk during a disaster?</li> </ul> <p>Language and Culture:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Do language and cultural barriers impact preparedness and response? How and why?</li> <li>• What languages are predominantly spoken, and how will this affect communication during emergencies?</li> <li>• Are there cultural differences in how information is received and acted upon?</li> </ul> <p>Traditional Knowledge:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What Traditional Knowledge and practices can be leveraged for resilience?</li> <li>• Are there traditional methods of risk reduction or environmental management that can be integrated into disaster planning?</li> <li>• How can cultural leaders and influencers be involved in emergency management efforts?</li> <li>• Has Indigenous Knowledge been integrated into emergency management strategies?</li> </ul> <p>Community Ties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How do cultural norms and values affect community cohesion and support?</li> <li>• Are there strong social networks and community ties that can be mobilized during a disaster?</li> <li>• How do cultural values shape mutual aid and collective action?</li> </ul> <p>Cultural Safety:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What are the cultural sensitivities and needs of different groups?</li> <li>• How can shelters and emergency services be made culturally safe and accessible?</li> <li>• What considerations are necessary for dietary, religious, or other cultural needs during emergencies?</li> <li>• Discrimination: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• How does historical discrimination affect current vulnerability?</li> <li>• How have past experiences of discrimination or marginalization shaped current trust in authorities and institutions?</li> </ul> </li> <li>• How can emergency management efforts build trust and ensure equitable participation?</li> </ul>
